Example 3: [Student's name] will require ◆◆yen to live in Japan for 1-year and within this amount, [student's name] will arrive to Japan with △△ yen and will withdraw money from my account as needed.

例 4 ; 一年間に必要な生活費◆◆万円のうち、来日時に△△万円持参し、残りは来日後▲▲万円送金します。また、必要に応じて勉学に支障のない範囲でアルバイトもする予定です。

Also, without interfering with his/her study, the [student] will carry out part-time work as necessary.

[Student's name] will arrive to Japan with △△ yen as required for all other living expenses. (In this case, rent is not required so the monthly amount for living expenses can be 30,000 ~ 40,000 yen)

例 6 ; 保証人と同居の予定です。一年間に必要な生活費は約◆◆万円です。そのうち、来日時に△△万円持参し、残りは本人に毎月▲▲万円手渡します。

(この場合、アパート代が必要ないので、一ヶ月の生活費は 3~4 万円でも可です)
